

Lonsdale Park Fishing Holidays

Conditions of Booking:



- Accommodation cannot be reserved until a £100 per week deposit has been paid.
- The balance should be paid six weeks before arrival.
- In certain instances an extra charge may be incurred should additional people decide to join your party .
- Prices for short breaks are available depending on the number in your party and the type of accommodation required.
- In the event of cancellation, Lonsdale Park reserves the right to obtain rental in full unless the accommodation can be re-let.
- In the event of cancellation by the proprietors, their liability will be to refund any monies paid.
- All male party bookings are by prior arrangement only in order to maintain our high standards of customer satisfaction and accommodation. No more than four males per unit will be allowed unless they are existing customers or are known to Lonsdale Park
- Electricity is provided by meter in the cottages and lodges.
- A refundable deposit is required for all units, this is £50 or in the case of all male groups - £150 and pet owners - £75. This is returned by post after cleaning, providing everything has been left as found upon arrival. Property, furniture and equipment will be inspected and an appropriate amount deducted for any excessive cleaning or damages, eg washing up or upholstery damage.
- The proprietors or any person in their employ cannot accept responsibility for any personal injury, loss or damage to personal property however caused.
- For their own safety and the convenience of other guests, children must be supervised by an adult at all times
- *Arrival times are between 3.00pm and 5.00pm on Friday.*
- *Departure time is by 10.00am on Friday.*
- Pets are only allowed in the Arches caravans, dogs are not allowed beyond Lonsdale Park's automatic gates.
- Lonsdale Park reserves the right to make certain changes without prior notification.
- Charges are made for accommodation sleeping additional persons. Caravans £95.00 per person per week, Lodges £120 per person per week.
- *Please consider insuring your holiday - it's better to be safe than sorry.*

Fishing Rules 2017:

Please respect the following rules, which must be adhered to, as they are for the benefit of fish and anglers alike:

- On arrival, residents must dip landing nets, unhooking mats, net bags, etc for 30 minutes and then rinse them in the tanks provided.
- Only barbless hooks are allowed. Crushed barbs, etc are not allowed and checks are made.
- All ledger rigs including method feeders must be free running and able to drop away in the event of a break off.
- Anglers are asked to be sensible with line strengths and to use a hook length which is weaker than their main line.
- Rods in use must never be left unattended - even when remote bite alarms are being used. If you leave it - you may lose it!
- Anglers may only use a maximum of two rods per person.
- Anglers must respect other anglers' swims by not casting across swims.
- Please do not 'reserve' pegs by leaving unattended tackle or bivvies.
- The siting of bivvies should be by arrangement.
- Only Lonsdale Park groundbait should be used. *Anglers are welcome to bring their own boilies and maggots, but we ask anglers to use only other baits that are Lonsdale endorsed (please contact us for details) and are available in the onsite tackle shop.*
- Specimen fish should be photographed kneeling down, over an unhooking mat. (Highly recommended safety unhooking mats are available in the shop at discounted price).
- Unhooking mats must be used for large fish.
- Anglers must use a minimum 8lb breaking strain line when fishing for Carp and a minimum breaking strain of 4lbs for other fish.
- When fishing the pole, anglers should use heavy elastic.
- Carp sacks may only be used by prior arrangement for the verification and photographing of large fish with the exception of Grass Carp, which should be released immediately. (Please ensure carp sacks are securely fixed).
- Clinic or a similar antiseptic should be carried by all anglers at all times. (Again this is available at a discounted price in the shop).
- Keep nets are not allowed, with the exception of during residents' matches.
- The use of trout pellets, Tiger Nuts and Peanuts is prohibited.
- Landing nets should be used on all but the smallest fish.
- Unauthorised live baiting is not allowed.
- Night Fishing is allowed!
- Residents can fish any peg with the exception of private pegs allocated to the accommodation.
- Anglers are asked to report any snapped off rigs, etc in trees or snags and to ensure they pick up all their own litter in order to protect our wildlife.
- Anglers should observe the speed limit on the approach road.
- If swans and ducks are present - please do not feed them.
- Cycling is not permitted around the lakes.

Lonsdale Park reserves the right to ask any person not adhering to the rules to leave
